Dance Team/Color Guard Director:

It is with great excitement I write you this letter. The Iowa High School Sports Network has agreed to join forces with the Iowa State Dance/Drill Team Association and award two \$500 scholarships to two graduating seniors. An application form is enclosed for you to distribute to one or two seniors (Duplicate form if necessary). Application must be postmarked by October 1, 2011.

Applications will be complete with the receipt of the application, high school transcript, three letters of recommendation, and responses to the questions. Personal interviews will be conducted on November 5 at Pella High School and attendance will be required to be eligible for the award. Announcement of this year's recipients will take place at the 2012 ISDTA competition December 1-2 in Des Moines.

Iowa High School Senior Scholarship Information & Eligibility:

- A. Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded by the Iowa High School Sports Network.
- B. Scholarships shall be for the purpose of education beyond the high school level.
- C. The scholarship will be paid upon receiving a letter of college acceptance.
- D. If the student receiving the scholarship decides not to go to an educational institute, they should notify ISDTA by June 1, 2012 so that it may be given to the first alternate.
- E. Two seniors per school may apply – Applicants (not an alternate or manager) must participate in the 2012 ISDTA Team Championships.
- F. GPA Minimum: 3.25 (current GPA at the time of application)
- G. Proof of enrollment at an educational institute must be received by ISDTA by June 1, 2012 to receive the scholarship.
- H. Application must be complete and postmarked by October 1.
- I. Finalists will be notified by mail prior to Nov. 5 to set up interview times.
- J. Application, official transcript, three letters of recommendation (teacher, dance team/color guard coach, and one of your choice) and answers to questions must be postmarked by Oct.1, 2011. **Combine all information into a portfolio/report form.**
- K. Any additional information you wish to add (newspaper clippings, photographs, etc.) to assist the selection committee will be accepted. If you wish to have items returned, enclose a self-addressed postage envelope.
- L. Enclose all information & letters of recommendation in one envelope/package.
